7 Lessons from 2016

Here are seven simple lessons God impressed upon us over the past 12 months. We hope these short points are also light for your path as you enter the exciting New Year!

1. Our joy and approval are found in Jesus Christ alone, not in affirmation or acceptance from people.
2. We can't worry about what everyone else may be thinking, but simply and boldly be who God has designed us to be.
3. Learn who you are. Who you are should shape what you do, rather than what you do shaping who you are.
4. Ministry skill-effectiveness often does not equate to ministry heart-faithfulness.
5. Being faithful to God isn't determined by our location but by our obedience.
6. We must be entirely God-dependent not self-reliant.
7. A pastor can pour his life into the lives of the people he is shepherding, but most of all the people need the life of Jesus far more than they need his life. So give them Jesus. Don't let them think for a moment that you're the savior they need. Only Jesus can be their Savior.
